

third-generation Ironworker, Brother William "Bill" Woodward was initiated into Dayton's Ironworkers Local No. 290 apprentice program in February 1980, from which he graduated to become a journeyman ironworker in 1983.

Since that time, Brother Woodward has worked at all facets of the trade, while earning his way up the ranks as a foreman, a general foreman and a superintendent.

Brother Woodward has also been an apprentice instructor, he sat on contract-negotiating committees, and he has served on many boards and building trades committees.

He was elected Business Manager of Local 290 in 2005 and remained in that position until being appointed President of the District Council of Southern Ohio & Vicinity in 2013 by Ironworkers International General President Walter Wise.

During that period, Brother Woodward sat on many boards and was involved in the training of new union officers, and he was appointed an Ohio Public Works Commissioner while he was serving the Southern Ohio and Vicinity District Council.

In 2017, he attended and graduated the Harvard University Trade Union Program, an intensive five-week executive training program designed for trade union leaders that teaches essential skills for the management and leadership of unions.

Brother Woodward was appointed Ninth General Vice-President of the Ironworkers International by General President Eric Dean in 2019 and has since moved up the ranks to Fifth General Vice President before retiring in 2022.
